



Statement from Rocky Point Future Planning Association Inc.

Mr David Huth, President of the Rocky Point Future Planning Association Inc presented the following statement at the i-METT Community Information Briefing conducted at the Beenleigh Community Centre on Wednesday 13th June 2007.

Our Association is working towards the development of the *whole of area* plan. Such a land use planning exercise would include the proposal to establish the integrated Motorsport, Education, Tourism and Technology precinct, together with the development of the extractive resources identified by the Department of Natural Resources and Water, the Steiglitz marine precinct, industrial and residential caneland under the Urban Footprint and the balance of the caneland for which future use is yet to be designated.

In the presentation of their proposal, i-METT have demonstrated an understanding of the issues affecting the whole of the area. Our Association wishes to take the unique opportunity for change that is presented, and work with all the stakeholders in determining future land use for the benefit of the local and wider communities in terms of sustainable, social, economic and environmental outcomes.
